科管所新進教師 申欽鳴 助理教授




申欽鳴 教授 為科技管理研究所新進教師,他個人的經歷相當特殊。申教授出生於韓國,中學之後隨家人移民至美國,他常自嘲自己不屬於任何一個國家,雖受傳統西方教育,是1.5代的<mark>韓裔美國人</mark>,但目前的身分為"half Chinese"(中國女婿)。

大學階段進入麻省理工學院,原本想成為一名火箭科學家,更具體來說,是想成為一名太空人,但事與願違。心想若學習經濟學或許能改善世界上的貧困問題。

My background really speaks to the strengths of CTM, which I think are expressed in diversity, inter-disciplinary approach, and cosmopolitanism.

I consider myself the newest member of the cosmopolitan trend in CTM.

I was born in Korea. In middle school, I was fortunate enough to have immigrated to the US, where I worked and lived since then. But, for the last 10 years or so, I spent most of my time half way across the globe in China, learning Mandarin, doing research, and even teaching for the past 1.5 years. As a result, like so many of our faculty in CTM, I straddle between many different countries, places, and cultures. I often half-jokingly admit: I don't belong to any country, which has some truth in it. I am a 1.5 generation Korean-American, yet deeply rooted in non-Western culture. I am educated in the Western traditions, yet I am now a "China Hand" or even a "half Chinese"(中國女婿), as my wife is a mainland Chinese. Even in terms of economic background, although it is a stretch to stay that my life is a rags-toriches story—because I'm not rich—my life has traversed a wide range of economic spectrum. Both of my parents were poor peasants in the countryside in Korea, and I myself lived there in the earliest years of my life. Twice before high school—once in Korea and once in the US—I didn't go to school because of my family's economic difficulties.

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Likewise, intellectually and academically, I come from a rather diverse background and training—again, much like many of my new colleagues in CTM. I went to MIT for my undergraduate, planning to become a rocket scientist (more specifically, an astronaut). When the epiphany hit me that I was not cut out to be one, I moved over to economics, thinking that I would like to solve poverty in the world…except it wasn't long before I realized that economists were generally nonchalant towards such an aspiration. I was at MIT at a time when empirical research was still the second-class citizen in the discipline. Everything was about theory (i.e., models) there at the time. Wanting something more "grounded" in human lives and communities, I chose to study city planning at UC Berkeley. My time at Berkeley was really the turning point in my academic life and the beginning of my interest in political economy, broadly defined. It continued when I returned to MIT for a Ph.D. in political science, where I specialized in political economy, comparative politics, and contemporary China.

One may ask what is someone like myself, who has little to offer in the way of practical training and know-how, doing in a "technology management" program. I would argue technology has everything to do with political economy writ large. Technology, almost by nature, sits right at the intersection between politics, society, and economy. We are at a point in time in which this is increasingly the case. We develop technology to benefit our society and economy. Yet, there is a real fear among a growing number of population that humanity is being subordinated to technology. To borrow the words of Karl Polanyi, we may be seeing the latest "double movement" unraveling right in front of our eyes. The unprecedented advancement in technology ushered in an unprecedented era of globalization and wealth generation since the 1980s. Yet, it can be argued that the same forces were the causes of the 2008 financial crisis and the rise of global populism. The latest triumphs of Brexit and Trump may be nothing more than an epiphenomenon of these underlying dynamics. In short, technology, even as an object of study, is not just a matter of technical and analytic question, but a moral and interpretive question. I hope I could offer the students in CTM some of the tools to understand, interpret, debate about, and cope with such questions.

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To those students who would like to brave through this journey with me and other faculty members in CTM, I would offer the following two cents: Ask big questions. Focus on fundamentals. Take classes in economics, sociology, anthropology, linguistics, physics, computer science, history, philosophy, and so on. Debate. Critique. Travel abroad. Study abroad. Read world news. Learn new cultures and languages. Don't take short-cuts. Beyond these, of course, take my classes.
