

National Tsing Hua University College of Technology and Management Guidelines for the Naming of Buildings/Facilities being Constructed/Renovated

Formulation approved at 4th College Affairs Meeting for Academic Year 2021 on March 9, 2022

- Article 1 These Guidelines are formulated to encourage individuals and **groups** who make donations for the College's building construction and facility renovation projects, and to properly manage and use the donated funds.
- Article 2 Construction-/renovation-/facilities-related donations to the College include public spaces such as classrooms, reading rooms, meeting rooms, etc.
- Article 3 A donor who donates an amount of NT\$2 million or more to finance all the funds or materials needed for a single space, or donates at least two-thirds of the funds needed for a building/facilities construction project where the total cost exceeds NT\$5 million, may name this building/space.**
- Article 4 Such building/facility naming must be negotiated between and agreed to by the College and the donor(s). Naming a space does not carry any meaning of ownership or long-term exclusivity. The ownership of the space belongs to the College, and the space shall be used by all faculty and students of the College.
- Article 5 These Guidelines take effect after being approved by the College Affairs Meeting. Any matters not stipulated here shall be handled through negotiation between Dean of the College and the donors.
