National Tsing Hua University College of Technology and Management Outstanding Alumni Selection Regulations

Approved at the 6th College Administration Meeting for Academic Year 2011 on March 20, 2012 Approved at the 1st College Affairs Meeting for Academic Year 2011 on May 29, 2012

- Article 1 These Regulations are formulated with the aim of recognizing CTM alumni's outstanding achievements and contributions, thereby inspiring junior fellows.
- Article 2 The College's alumni, who do not serve as the University's current full-time faculty, research fellows, or professional/technical personnel, that meet one of the following eligibility requirements may be selected as the College's outstanding alumni candidates:
 - 1. Alumni with outstanding achievements in their profession or career.
 - 2. Alumni who have made special contributions to society.
 - 3. Alumni who have made significant contributions to the building or development of the University or the College.
- Article 3 The ex-officio College Outstanding Alumni Selection Committee members are the Dean of the College and heads of the departments/institutes/programs. Several members can also be appointed by the Dean from inside/outside the University to jointly form the Committee, with the Dean acting as the convener.
- Article 4 College outstanding alumni candidates shall be endorsed by at least three department/institute/program committee members or selection members, and shall be nominated by December 15 each year. Those approved by the Selection Committee after discussion and evaluation will become the College's outstanding alumni. The outstanding alumni candidates list shall not be publicly revealed during the process of nomination and evaluation. In principle, one candidate can be nominated for the outstanding alumni selection by each department/institute/program each year.

- Article 5 In principle, the number of outstanding alumni being selected shall not exceed one.
- Article 6 Outstanding College alumni shall be awarded certificates by the Dean and be recognized publicly.
- Article 7 These Regulations take effect after being approved by the College Affairs Meeting. The same applies with any amendments/revisions
