National Tsing Hua University College of Technology Management CTM Distinguished Professorship Appointment Guidelines (Draft)

Approved at the 1st College Affairs Meeting for the 2020 academic year on October 7, 2020 Approved at the College 1st Faculty Review Committee for the 2020 academic year on October 14, 2020 Amended and approved at the College 2nd Faculty Review Committee for the 2020 academic year on December 9, 2020

- Article 1 In order to recruit and retain outstanding talents with excellent academic achievements both domestically and abroad, and **in accordance with Article 5** of the Regulations for the Establishment of Named and College-level Distinguished Professors of National Tsing Hua University and **with reference to** the Regulations for the Establishment of Chairs and Distinguished Professors of National Tsing Hua University, the National Tsing Hua University College of Technology Management (hereinafter referred to as the "College") establishes these Guidelines.
- Article 2 Qualifications for Distinguished Professor A full-time professor or newly-recruited scholar of international reputation who will be teaching or conducting research on campus for at least one year, who has one of the following academic honors or achievements, and who has consistently demonstrated outstanding performance in the past five years:
 - (1) Received the Outstanding Research Award from the Ministry of Science and Technology once
 - (2) Received the University's Outstanding Teaching Award twice.
 - (3) Received two of the following awards: the University's Outstanding Teaching Award, Outstanding Industry-Academia Research Award (can only be counted once), or Outstanding Mentor Award.
 - (4) Received one individual award as part of the National Innovation Awards.
 - (5) Received other academic honors or achievements of equivalent level.

There is no maximum number of candidates for a given year, so long as they meet the qualifications above; a given year may also have no candidates.

Article 3 The procedures for recommending and appointing distinguished professors in the College of Technology Management: Full-time professors of the University who meet the conditions in Article 2 shall be recommended by the departments and institutes and approved by the Faculty Review Committee.

- Article 4 The honorary bonus for distinguished professors in the College of Technology Management shall be financed **by the College's own funds, and** the Dean is authorized to set **the amount of the bonus**.
- Article 5 Distinguished professors in the College of Technology Management are obligated to enhance the University's academic quality; the academic tasks to be undertaken by them shall be agreed upon by the Dean and the distinguished professors.
- Article 6 The term of office of distinguished professors in the College of Technology Management is the same as that of full-time professors.
- Article 7 These Guidelines shall take effect once approved by the College's Faculty Review Committee and sent to the University's Faculty Review Committee for review and approval.
