National Tsing Hua University College of Technology and Management Regulations on Honorary Title Conferment

- Article 1 These Regulations are formulated by the National Tsing Hua University College of Technology and Management (hereinafter referred to as the College) to honor people in academia/industry who have made outstanding contributions to academia industry. Those with or domestically/internationally recognized academic achievements outstanding reputation may be recommended as candidates for the College's honorary chair titles. Those with outstanding contributions to the College's related research fields, or with the industry's advanced practical experiences may be recommended as candidates for College honorary professors.
- Article 2 There are no restrictions imposed on the countries or regions where recommended candidates may come from. However, candidates must not be current University full-time faculty members; and candidates for honorary professors must not be the University's retired teachers.

Article 3 Recommendation and deliberation procedures:

Candidates may be nominated by heads of the College's departments/institutes, or be recommended to departments/institutes through signatures of five or more of the College's faculty members. Titles of Honorary Chair or Honorary Professor will be conferred after the nomination or recommendation is approved by department/institute faculty evaluation committees and the College Faculty Evaluation Committee.

- Article 4 No more than three Honorary Chair and Honorary Professor titles total may be approved and conferred by the College each year.
- Article 5 These Regulations take effect after being approved in the College Affairs Meeting. The same applies with any amendments/revisions.
