親愛的珮慈，恭喜你真的走到這裡了。四年前，妳提著行李走進清華的那一天，沒想到自己會變得這麼不一樣吧？那時候的妳會在課堂上不敢舉手、不知道自己喜歡什麼、也以為「大學好像就該有標準答案」。但現在的妳，不只可以跟來自世界各國的同事協調專案，也能在近百人面前主持講座，還會在日記裡問自己：「我今天做的事，離我想成為的人近了一點嗎？」這一路上妳不是沒有猶豫、沒有哭過、沒有閃躲過，只是每一次都還是選擇了「再走一步看看好了」。這份韌性，比任何 GPA 或實習都更值得驕傲。未來也請繼續用這種方式活著：真誠、熱血、有點傻，但永遠不後悔。

2. 請分享一個在大學中特別難忘的經歷或回憶。

大四那年，我到中美洲的貝里斯進行海外實習，協助當地代謝性慢性病防治體系強化計劃的行銷推廣。有一次我跟著醫療團一起前往偏鄉社區協助義診，那天的我不是專業人員，只是負責拍照、記錄、幫忙報到，但卻深刻記得某個畫面：一位媽媽帶著三個小孩，從遠處走了好幾公里，只為了能見到醫師、領取一週份的藥。我站在義診現場，看著那一排排等待的小孩與老人，忽然有一種「我們在這裡，是有意義的」的感覺。我沒有行醫的



專業，但我能寫報表、整理資料、協助醫療物資的分配。我第一次這麼具體地感受到：「社會貢獻」不一定要轟轟烈烈，而是你是否願意，把自己擅長的事，用在需要的地方。那次的義診讓我後來回台灣之後，重新思考自己能怎麼結合行銷專業、經濟思維與公共議題的關注，走出一條屬於自己的路。

3. 在您的大學生涯中，您最喜歡的課程是哪一門？為什麼？

我最喜歡的課是總體經濟學，特別是學到 IS-LM 模型和凱因斯思想的部分。這門課不像某些技能課可以馬上看到應用成果，但它讓我開始用一種「放大鏡視角」去理解這個世界——什麼是政府支出的短期刺激？為什麼通膨有時反而是景氣恢復的訊號？我第一次發現，原來一個國家的景氣、失業與政策，不只是新聞標題，而是可以用模型去分析、預測與理解的。這堂課不只讓我對經濟產生興趣，也幫我釐清了自己的方向：我想走在「商業理解與社會影響力」的交界上。更重要的是，它讓我相信：即使我不是理工科出身，只要我具備足夠的視角與邏輯，就一樣可以用社會科學的方式，參與這個世界的改變。

4. 您在大學中參與的任何社團或組織有哪些？這些活動對您的成長有何影響？

我曾擔任商研社副社長、微軟校園大使，也在管顧社做過專案、做過科管院永續競賽、到軟體業實習、去中美洲參與國際組織。這些經驗對我來說，比起課堂知識，更像是真實世界的預演。在商研社，我從零開始設計一整套十二週的課程規劃，並用內容行銷在一週內成功招募新社員；參加競賽的過程中，我學會怎麼在混亂中整合資源、帶著團隊一起扛住壓力，並找出解方；而實習與海外經驗，則教我怎麼跨文化溝通、怎麼在變動中保持穩定與彈性。我不敢說自己特別厲害，但我知道自己已經變成一個能處理變數、願意挺身而出、也不忘保持溫度的人。而這一切，都要謝謝清大這個充滿奇怪又精彩靈魂的地方，讓我學會怎麼走出自己的路。


