

National Tsing Hua University College of Technology Management Guidelines for the Establishment of the Outstanding Teaching Award for Full-Time Faculty

1. This College has established these Guidelines to reward the long-term teaching effectiveness of full-time faculty members, enhance their teaching enthusiasm, and expand teaching outcomes.

2. Target Recipients: Full-time faculty members who have taught in this College for 2 years or more.

3. Frequency of Selection: Held once per academic year.

4. Quota: Up to 3 recipients.

5. Award Content: Awardees shall receive a cash prize of NT\$20,000 (funded by the self-raised budget of the College) and public recognition. Awardees who receive the University-level Outstanding Teaching Award in the same academic year shall not concurrently receive the monetary award of this College's Outstanding Teaching Award.

6. Recommendation and Review Procedures:

(1) Each department, institute, as well as the EMBA and IMBA programs, may recommend 1 to 2 candidates to the College by the end of March each year.

(2) For the review of the Outstanding Teaching Award, candidates may be requested to submit written materials, such as their teaching philosophy, teaching methods, and student teaching evaluation surveys from the past 3 years, to the College.

(3) The Dean shall appoint a total of 4 to 6 members to form a Review Committee.

(4) Operation of the Review Committee:

1. Select up to 3 outstanding teaching faculty members.
2. Recommend 1 to 2 candidates (depending on the University's notification) as candidates for the annual University-level Outstanding Teaching Award.

7. Faculty members who receive this Award shall not be eligible as candidates for this teaching award for one academic year following the award.

8. Faculty members who receive the University-level Outstanding Teaching Award shall not be eligible as candidates for this College's Outstanding Teaching Award for 2 academic years following the award. Faculty members who have received the

University-level Outstanding Teaching Award a total of 3 times shall no longer be eligible for this teaching award.

9. These Guidelines shall be implemented after being approved by the College Affairs Meeting.
